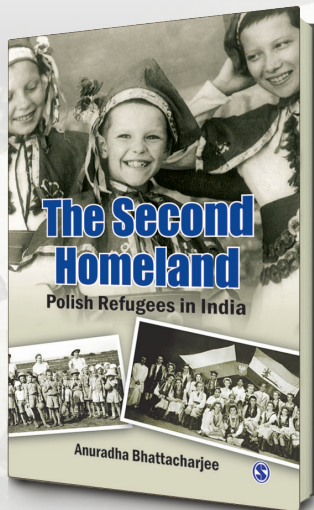

Tube

The nearest tube stations are:

Green Park - Jubilee, Victoria, Piccadilly lines.
